- Flashlight/radio/ extra batteries
- Sanitation supplies
- Pet supplies, food, water, waste bags, carrier, leash
- Pet vet, vaccine records & medical records, medicine, picture of you with your pet
- Shoes
- Comfort item(s) ie kids stuffed animal
- Work gloves, hat
- Safety goggles

Specialty items to think about

- Easily carried valuables, jewelry, small art, figurines, coins, certificates
- Safe deposit box or lock box keys
- Photos
- PC or hard drive
- Chargers
- Originals of important papers or copies, birth certificate, passport
- Other medical info, health insurance card, list of doctors, pharmacy, hard copies of prescriptions

- 1. Crate or carrier for each pet large enough for the pet to turn around in and cat carriers large enough for a small litter box
- 2. Pet Identification Forms for each pet with photos attached
- 3. Collar and leash for all pets (including cats) with ID and rabies tags on all collars
- 4. Vaccination records of each pet
- 5. Three-week supply of each pets medications
- 6. Sedatives for pets that frighten easily
- 7. Disposable litter boxes and scoop
- 8. Extra cat litter
- 9. Plastic bags, paper towels, and cleaning supplies
- 10. Three-week supply of food for each pet
- 11. Manual can opener
- 12. Food and water bowls for each pet
- 13. Supply of drinking water
- 14. Toys or blankets your pet will find familiar
- 15. Towels
- 16. Grooming items
- 17. Detailed instructions for animal care and rescue workers
- 18. Copy of emergency numbers and family evacuation plan
- 19. Copy of veterinarian's information
- 20. Flashlight and batteries
- 21. Pet first aid kit: include bandaging material, antiseptic ointment, alcohol, gloves, tweezers, muzzle, and gauze
- 22. List of all hotels accepting pets in the area
- 23. First aid books for pets and humans

- Variety of bandages
- Antibiotic ointment
- Antiseptic wipes
- Tweezers
- Cold compress
- Gloves
- Gauze pads and roller bandages
- Thermometer
- Pain reliever
- Face mask for smoke rated N95
- Specialty supplies ie. Diabetes, prescription meds

Neighbors

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Who needs help?

Who is home during the day?

Who has kids? Pets?

Do you share contact info?

Evacuation Plan- some info overlaps Family Disaster Plan above but have you done it?!

- When will you leave? Uncomfortable, Alert or mandatory notice?
- Designate 2 meeting locations
 - One right outside home
 - One outside your neighborhood
- Know your escape routes
 - From your home
 - From your neighborhood
- Have an evacuation plan for pets and livestock
- Have a family communication plan
 - Who is your out of area contact?
 - How will kids get picked up from school?
 - How will you connect with each other's office or location?
- How do you access voicemail from alternate phone? Number and PIN
- Consider changing your outgoing voicemail greeting after evacuating include:
 - Your safety
 - Your location
 - Outside contact person's info

Is your plan in writing, do all household members know it, have you practiced?
